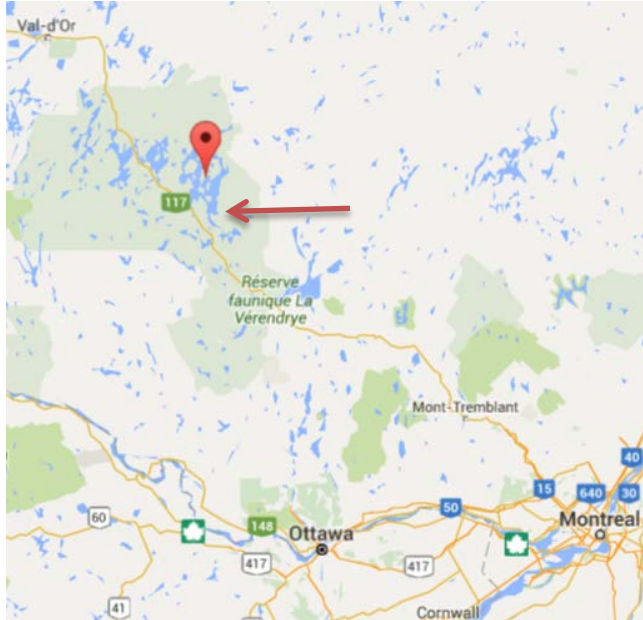

FIELD TRIPS...



Cabonga Reservoir



August 19-21 - Southeastern shore of the Cabonga Reservoir for Spinel, Moonstone, red Garnet, grey Corundum and other minerals. The claim owner Mr. Olivier Langelier will give us a 3 day guided tour of the area by land and by boat.

The Cabonga reservoir is located between Maniwaki and Val d'Or ~ 3 hours drive north of Ottawa. We will be camping Friday and Saturday nights at the little town of Le Domaine ~ 20 minutes drive from the collecting areas.

There is only one small mine dump in the area. Most collecting will be on boulders and in the sand above Calcite outcrops. The vegetation is thick Spruce forest that has been clear cut in places. Boat access to the reservoir is no problem. In late August the logging roads should be in good shape.

I would enjoy taking members to the old standbys. Examples are perthite at Rideau Ferry, peristerite at the Perth location, corundum at Craigmont and/or Burgess, various at Quadville and apatite at Miller. Some of these locations have the possibility of interesting additional activities if there is time and interest.

I hope to get out a tentative schedule for local field trips this week and will send it soon.

...FIELD TRIPS!

On April 23, 2016

Depending on the weather, I plan to have a field trip to MacDonald Mine near Bancroft.

Geology: The mine occurs in a zoned pegmatite dyke, with a central core of massive quartz, an intermediate zone of coarse-grained quartz and microcline-perthite, a wall zone of medium grained albite-microcline-quartz and border zone of fine grained graphic granite. Feldspar crystals up to one metre in length can be seen in the central pillar, and pyroxenes and allanite occur up to 30 centimetres long.

Minerals: White, pink and red massive feldspar, (some peristerite), milky to smoky quartz, graphic granite, allanite, pyrite, cyrtolite zircon, uranopyrochlore (ellsr, vorthite). Other recorded minerals include: scapolite, pyrrhotite, fluorite (purple), magnetite, ilmenite, chalcopyrite, and galena.

Special note: The mine is under reclamation so it will be surface collecting only. There are also conflicting information about access. A report on MinDat states that the mine is closed to collectors (as of 2013). This is true for the mine proper but the area is still listed as a collecting point in the Bancroft Chamber of Commerce guide. Maybe we can have access to the dumps. I will contact the BCoC to find out what is happening and I will let everyone know by e-mail.

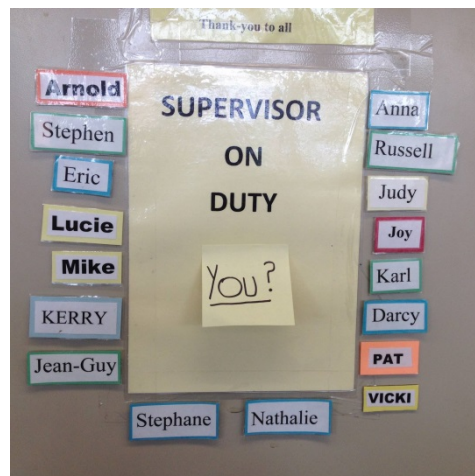
